

Think Spring! The *Wells College Seed Exchange* program opened this week for the 2019 growing season. Our seed exchange cabinet was loaded with over 1500 packets of different varieties of vegetable, herb, and flower seeds. Seeds were donated by more than 20 different seed companies as well as by local gardeners who saved seeds from last year's bounty. We may receive a few more seed shipments, but don't delay – once the exchange is open, the seed stock disperses quickly. *Come and get 'em!*

All seeds in our exchange program are available for free. Please note that most seed offered is from last season (which is why companies donate it to us); we offer no warranties about germination rates although most seeds should grow just fine. To make our seed supply go further, we provide small seed envelopes at the seed exchange desk; dispense just the quantity of seed you need for your garden. We request that you sign in our guest book and follow the simple guidelines posted next to the exchange cabinet. We offer information about seed saving at the exchange; those little seed envelopes may be used for you to contribute excess seed back to the exchange at the end of this growing season.

The *Wells College Seed Exchange* is located on the 2nd floor of Long Library, around the corner to the right from the circulation desk. The exchange is available to the public during library hours: Monday-Thursday: 8:30AM-Midnight; Friday: 8:30AM-6PM; Saturday: 10:00AM-6PM; and Sunday: 11AM-Midnight. (Note: Library hours will be different during the college's Spring Break, March 8-17; check the Library website for updated hours).

Free visitor parking closest to the Library is available in the Woods Lot.
