COVID-19 Testing in Cayuga County

92 tests have been performed by Cayuga County Health Department

We are awaiting the results of 43 tests that were performed on Cayuga County residents by the Cayuga County Health Department, physicians, healthcare facilities and licensed clinical laboratories.

Mandatory Quarantine/ Isolation

44 in mandatory quarantine

2 in mandatory isolation

We were able to discharge two individuals from mandatory isolation today, Friday, March 27, 2020.

DEFINITIONS –

Mandatory quarantine –

A person who:

- had direct contact with a confirmed case, regardless of their symptoms, or
- traveled internationally and has symptoms.



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Mandatory isolation –

A person who is a confirmed COVID case will be placed into mandatory isolation. Each case will be discharged from isolation when they meet criteria for discharge set forth by the New York State Department of Health.
