New Cases -

Seven new cases. They are identified as:

- A male in his 30's, living inside the City.
- A male in his 30's, living outside the City.
- A male in his 30's, living outside the City.
- A female in her 30's, living outside the City.
- A 4 year old male, living outside the City.
- A female in her 30's, living outside the City.
- A male in his in his 20's, living outside the City.

Contact tracing has been completed for five of the seven confirmed cases.

23 Mandatory Isolation

Hospitalized patients

Of the 23 people in Mandatory Isolation, one patient currently hospitalized.

Confirmed Cases – total year to date

There have been a total of 44 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Cayuga County.

Discharges- total year to date

There have been a total of 20 individuals discharged from mandatory isolation

Deaths – total year to date

One death related to COVID-19 in our county.

Test Results Received –

Number of test results received since testing began in early March – **637** as of today.
