Cayuga County Covid-19 Situational Update as of 7:15pm

New Cases -

Two new cases today.

One is a male in his 20's living in the City of Auburn, working on an agricultural farm.

One is a male in his 30's living outside the City of Auburn working on a dairy farm.

Contact tracing investigations are underway for both confirmed cases.

Confirmed Cases – total year to date

There have been six total confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Cayuga County.

Test Results Received –

Number of test results received since testing began earlier in March – **301** as of today.

- This information includes all testing of Cayuga County residents by physicians, healthcare facilities and licensed clinical laboratories.

Results pending –

As of today, we are awaiting the results of 45 tests that were performed on Cayuga County residents by the Cayuga County Health Department, physicians, healthcare facilities and licensed clinical laboratories.

Hospitalized patients

Of the three cases currently in isolation, zero are hospitalized.

Deaths

There have been no deaths related to COVID-19 in our county.
