Cayuga County Covid-19 Situational Update as of 4:00pm

New Cases -

11 new cases today.

Contact tracing investigations are on-going for all eleven cases.

Again, the purpose of a contact investigation is to determine who the confirmed cases came into contact with. The Health Department then notifies those individuals and places them under mandatory quarantine order. If you were not notified by the Cayuga County Health Department, you were not a direct contact.

Confirmed Cases – total year to date

There have been 28 total confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Cayuga County.

Test Results Received –

Number of test results received since testing began in early March – **492** as of today.

- This information includes all testing of Cayuga County residents by physicians, healthcare facilities and licensed clinical laboratories.

The Cayuga County Health Department will receive results on any Cayuga County resident who was tested for COVID-19 even if they were tested out of county.

Results pending –

As of today, we are awaiting the results of 36 tests that were performed on Cayuga County residents by the Cayuga County Health Department, physicians, healthcare facilities and licensed clinical laboratories.

Hospitalized patients

One individual, in isolation is hospitalized. This individual is stable.

Deaths

One death related to COVID-19 in our county.

Mandatory Quarantine/ Isolation

35 in mandatory quarantine

23 in mandatory isolation

Individuals that are confirmed COVID cases are placed into Mandatory Isolation. Contacts of confirmed cases are placed into Mandatory Quarantine. These are written legal orders issued by the Public Health Director. The purpose of these orders is to reinforce the importance of compliance and restricts their movement.

The Cayuga County Health Department conducts monitoring of the individuals in mandatory quarantine and isolation daily, with telephone calls and unannounced in-person visits, to ensure compliance of the legal order which restricts their movement.

Additional details:

- The age ranges of these confirmed cases ranges from three and a half months old through sixty years old, with an average age of 30 years old.
