New Cases – 4 new cases

- A female in her twenties living inside the City of Auburn
- A female in her fifties living inside the City of Auburn
- A male in his forties living inside the City of Auburn
- A female in her forties living outside the City of Auburn

The Health Department investigates all COVID-19 cases in Cayuga County and identifies and notifies all close contacts. Contact tracing is on-going.

Hospitalized patients

No hospitalized Cayuga County residents at this time.

Confirmed Cases – total year to date

There have been a total of 62 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Cayuga County.

Discharges- total year to date

There have been 51 individuals discharged from Mandatory Isolation.
