Cayuga County COVID-19 Situational Update as of 4:00pm

New Cases- no new cases

- There was a transcription error reported to the New York State laboratory system from Boston Heart Diagnostic Lab, the laboratory that analyzes Covid-19 specimens from Well Now Urgent Care. Subsequently, a positive COVID test result was reported in the June 9, 2020 press release. The test result was negative. We have adjusted our numbers in today's press release which accurately reflects the number of confirmed COVID-19 cases to date.

45 in Mandatory Quarantine

8 in Mandatory Isolation

Hospitalized patients

Three Cayuga County residents are hospitalized at this time.

Confirmed Cases – total year to date

There have been a total of 104 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Cayuga County.

Discharges- total year to date

There have been 95 individuals discharged from Mandatory Isolation.

Deaths

One death related to COVID-19 in our county.
