Hospitalized patients

Three Cayuga County residents are hospitalized at this time.

Confirmed Cases – total year to date

There have been a total of 106 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Cayuga County.

Discharges- total year to date

There have been 97 individuals discharged from Mandatory Isolation.

Deaths

One death related to COVID-19 in our county.

Additional Information- Cayuga County has entered Phase 3 today of Reopen New York. Additionally, garage sales and yard sales are now permissible. Garage and yard sales – as informal events for the sale of used goods by private individuals in residential settings – are permitted to operate so long as sellers ensure that (1) occupancy of the space used for the sale is limited to the number of people who can be safely and appropriately spaced such that each person is at least six feet away from others and, in no case, should the space be occupied by more than 10 people at any given time, in accordance with [Executive Order 202.33](#), as extended; (2) appropriate face coverings must be used by people in areas or situations where they are likely to come within six feet of another individual, in accordance with [Executive Order 202.17](#), as extended; and (3) adequate hand hygiene supplies (e.g. hand sanitizer) and regular
