New cases

Saturday, July 25, 2020 – no new cases. No hospitalized cases.

Sunday, July 26, 2020 – no new cases. No hospitalized cases.

Monday, July 27, 2020 – one new case. No hospitalized cases.

Hospitalized Cases

Currently there are no Cayuga County residents hospitalized.

Confirmed Cases – total year to date

There have been a total of 138 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Cayuga County.

Discharges- total year to date

There have been 130 individuals discharged from Mandatory Isolation.

Deaths

There have been three Cayuga County deaths related to COVID-19.
