### **New cases**

Saturday, August 22, 2020 – 2 new cases.

- A male in his fifties, living outside the City of Auburn.

Sunday, August 23, 2020 – 1 new case.

- A female in her thirties, living inside the City of Auburn.

Monday, August 24, 2020 – 3 new cases.

- A female in her forties, living outside the City of Auburn.

- A male in his twenties, living outside the City of Auburn.

### **Hospitalized Cases**

Currently there no Cayuga County residents hospitalized.

### **Confirmed Cases – total year to date**

There have been a total of 170 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Cayuga County.

### **Discharges- total year to date**

There have been 159 individuals discharged from Mandatory Isolation.

### **Deaths**

There have been three Cayuga County deaths related to COVID-19.

Our communicable disease investigations have revealed that some of our more recent confirmed COVID-19 cases involve individuals who were asymptomatic and were tested as part of routine screening for employment and medical procedures. This information is being shared to reinforce the importance of wearing a face covering both indoors and outdoors when safe social distancing (six feet apart) cannot be maintained.
