## **Potential COVID-19 Exposure at Don Juan Cafe in Auburn**

The Cayuga County Health Department is informing the public of a potential exposure to COVID-19 at Don Juan Cafe, 104 Chapman Ave, Auburn, NY 13021. An employee has tested positive for COVID-19 and was working:

- Thursday, October 1 from 8:30am – 1pm
- Friday, October 2 from 8:30am – 1pm
- Saturday, October 3 from 8:30am – 1pm
- Thursday, October 8 from 8:30am – 10:30am

Members of the public who were at the restaurant during the timeframes listed above may have been exposed and should monitor themselves for symptoms of COVID-19 for 14 days from the date of potential exposure.

People with COVID-19 have had a wide range of symptoms reported – ranging from mild symptoms to severe illness. Symptoms may appear **2-14 days after exposure to the virus**. People with these symptoms may have COVID-19:

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing

This list does not include all possible symptoms. If symptoms do develop, stay home, and call your doctor for further guidance. If you are elderly, have underlying medical conditions, or are immunocompromised, call your doctor early even if your illness is mild. In an emergency, call 911.
